

PAC Meeting Minutes, April 4, 2016

Meeting called to order @ 7:09 pm. 12 Members in attendance, including Mr. Thompson.
Motion to adopt last meeting minutes: Danielle Palivos; Second: Deb Stewart

Chairperson's Report (Stephanie Pettie)

- Playground build will happen this Saturday. A list of the tools needed has been sent to the volunteers and it looks like we have enough and won't need to rent or buy any. Cobs has donated scones for breakfast, and coffee and fruit are set for the morning. Ryan Wellington has agreed to cater the lunch. We will need to arrange security for the playground until 8pm until the concrete sets (Marilyn, Steph and Velda Low agreed to do security). A time lapse video of the build will be set up.
- PAC elections will be May. The secretary and treasurer positions will need to be filled.

Treasurer's Report (Tasha Mangat)

- Current balance of main account from February is \$14,253. Gaming account is only \$10 so we will need to transfer funds to cover fees until next October when the gaming fund will be received. The current balance of the main account is just enough to cover the usual requests for the next year, though we will still need to pay for the concrete for the playground from this balance as well.

Fundraising (Michelle Miller / Esme Kanda)

- Bingo night will be on Thursday, April 28. There will be a concession of hot dogs and drinks and snacks. Doors will open at 545 to allow for concession sales. Bingo will start at 615 and is expected to run to 730pm. There will be ten bingo games. There will also be 50-50 ticket sales. Steph has arranged for the gaming licenses. Pre sales for both concession and bingo tickets will be arranged to better plan for food amounts. Unused Bingo dabbers were returned last time so the plan is to buy extra supplies and return any unopened extras. Set up of gym will be at 2pm so allow parents picking up kids at 3pm to arrive a little earlier to set up instead of staying after school.
