Parents are responsible for transporting their child to and from the meet.

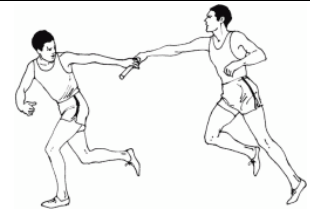
