## Principal's Message

It has been a VERY busy week as we wrapped our heads around last Friday's message from the Education Minister that schools will be moving into Stage 3 (voluntary part-time in-class instruction) on June 1<sup>st</sup>. You have received a letter in a separate email with more details around our health and safety plan as well as a link to a survey for parents to let us know if you are planning to send your child(ren) back to school.

Staff will be returning to the building this week in order to create our safe and distanced spaces, manage movement, coordinate schedules, and figure out details like staggered entrance to classes/recess/lunches/dismissals/etc.

Parents are asked to monitor their child's health closely each day as no adults or children who exhibit symptoms (even mild) of cold, influenza, Covid-19, or other infectious respiratory disease will be allowed in the building.

Our community has stayed healthy because of physical distancing, frequent hand-washing, and staying home when sick. This must continue as part of the safe practices for in-class instruction.
